Faced with the impending demolition of SDPD's largest historical artifact, the San Diego Police Historical Association released the now famous Old Police Headquarters badge in 1997 as a fundraiser to help save the building. More than 1000 units of our now official badge were sold and the funds help launch not only the museum but a groundswell of support that led to the magnificent building being listed on the National Register of Historic Places and ultimately saved.

Minted in gold, silver and bronze coloring, and individually customized to your rank and number specifications, this stunning badge captures the iconic 68 foot tower as its centerpiece and is reflective of the 48 years (1939-1987) that the Old HQ served SDPD.
